# Staff mobility for teaching from the Royal University of Bhutan (RUB), Bhutan to the Georg-August-Universität Göttingen (UGOE), Germany

#### **General overview:**

The Georg-August-Universität Göttingen (UGOE) offers in the field of **Agriculture**, **Forestry or Information and Communication Technologies**:

- 1 Staff mobility for teaching (from RUB to UGOE) with a duration of 14 days (excluding travel days).

For teaching staff: A minimum of 8 hours of teaching per week at the host university has to be respected. Staff applicants should apply for the scholarship with an invitation letter from a potential supervisor of the Host University.

#### Insurance:

All grant holders are insured by a central Group Insurance, which will be centrally organised by the Project Coordination Team upon successful nomination. The insurance costs (approximately 0,90 EUR per day) are deducted from the individual support.
